And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.”* (Luke 23:34)

*“Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day: Lest when thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt therein; And when thy herds and thy flocks multiply, and thy silver and thy gold is multiplied, and all that thou hast is multiplied; Then thine heart be lifted up, and thou forget the LORD thy God, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage; **Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water; who brought thee forth water out of the rock of flint; Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end; And thou say in thine heart, My power and the might of mine hand hath gotten me this wealth. But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto***

thy fathers, as it is this day. And it shall be, if thou do at all forget the LORD thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish. As the nations which the LORD destroyeth before your face, so shall ye perish; because ye would not be obedient unto the voice of the LORD your God.” (Deuteronomy 8:11-20)

May we all be content in His wilderness and stay focused on straying sheep and not on houses, lands, with their gold and silver. “Then drew near unto him all the publicans and sinners for to hear him. And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them. And he spake this parable unto them, saying, What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost, until he find it? And when he hath found it, he layeth it on his shoulders, rejoicing. And when he cometh home, he calleth together his friends and neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost. I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over **one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.**” (Luke 15:1-7)

Brothers and Sisters remain in the wilderness with the Good Shepherd and do not allow yourself to be allured by talent, music, human friendship, laughter and partying of the un-repentant carnal church of today. Seek lost souls and be content with what our God provides being focused about our Father's business!! It is appointed unto man once to die and after that God's judgment! The only thing you can carry to eternity is your soul and other souls you can influence whether it is eternity in heaven or eternity in hell! You will be with Lazarus or be with the rich man on the other side of that great gulf fixed!

I was in my jail cell asleep one night when I woke up at 2:00 AM and felt a strong urge to open my cell mate's King James Bible (I didn't have one) I got up and got his Bible off the table and just flipped it open. The first verses I saw was Isaiah 41:9-16  
9. "Thou whom I have taken from the ends of the earth, and called thee from the chief men thereof, and said unto thee, Thou art my servant; I have chosen thee, and not cast thee away.  
10. Fear thou not; for I am with thee; be not dismayed; for I am thy God; I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness."

As I read those two verses tears was rolling down my face!  
I had killed a man, but here God was telling me, He had not cast me away.  
I grew up in a Christian home, but all my life I had ran from God. I was a "Chief of sinners," I had ran, you might say, to the "ends of the earth!" I got on my knees and accepted Jesus Christ into my heart as I repented of all my sins.  
I pleaded guilty and took Life plus 50 years in prison.

I cried as I read these issues of "Miracles & Missions Digest," because it has been along time since I've heard anyone preach like you do! God Bless you Brother!  
I thought no one preached the TRUTH any more except us. Most Churches preach the PROSPERITY DOCTRINE, such as Kenneth Copeland, and a lot of others! I'm not afraid to call them by name, if the truth hurts, them get right with God!
