

# *Madagascar Missions 2024*

Dear Brother Skinner,

This is a brief report of concerning recent church buildings and some other activities of Jesosy Mamonjy Pentelotista M A Daoud in Madagascar.

“A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.” (Proverbs 7: 7)

The above quotation is meaningful to us, the Jesosy Mamonjy M. A. Daoud Church in Madagascar. For we were helpless, rejected and in minority. We started from a handful of believers that were grounded and settled in faith, and not moved away from the sound and holy doctrine taught by the Founder (Brother Daoud). Now we are settled all over Madagascar with no less than 300 churches and home services. We thank God that sent IBA through Brother Skinner on His due time to assist us. We won't be thankful enough to IBA and Brother Skinner because of the great and constant help done in Madagascar. As a result the Church growth is promising. Praise the Lord! The help is used mainly in purchasing lands, building churches, maintaining and purchasing equipment such as cars, motor cycles, bikes and P A systems, the last but not the least support of Pastors and Preachers.

Brother and Sister Daoud first came to Madagascar In 1961. At that time in Antananarivo they couldn't find large enough places to receive people for the meeting, so they choose a rugby stadium not far from Jesosy Mamonjy current church. Then there was a very few cars in the Capital but the thirst to hear the Gospel created a rush and such jams that the traffics were paralyzed every day so the Government decided to stop the Evangelization and moved it to a suburb called FENOARIVO (the country of Brother Joro, by his mother side), approximately 20km from the Capital, that could receive thousands of people. After Antananarivo, the Capital they went to preach the Gospel to the other five provinces which are: Diego, Majunga, Tamatave, Fianarantsoa and Tulear God confirmed His work by many miracle. After those, they went back to America. Then came back again to Madagascar and started home churches services. But in 1963, just in the opposite of a great company (Henri Fraise) where the father of Brother Joro was working, Brother Daoud came with rented trucks that carried earth to bank up a large miry place. Right there was built the first Jesosy Mamonjy's Church. Praise the Lord! From 1961 till 1967 there was a great revival in Jesosy Mamonjy , so many souls were saved. Many great responsible of different churches quitted their churches to follow Jesus with the pure and sound doctrine of Jesosy Mamonjy . All of that aroused jealousy and hatred in the formal churches. The Government expelled Brother and Sister Daoud out of Madagascar, they gave an allotted time of 48 hours to them to pack up and go home. The reason was: "unwanted presence"!!!The Government had the church closed down during 5 years. Nevertheless during that time there were 27 home church services in secret because of persecution. But even though the brotherly love was so tight as ever before. And in 1972 the Church was officially reopened, Glory to God! But only, 25 years after their departure (1991) Brother and Sister Daoud were allowed to be back again in Madagascar. Sister Daoud was gone to glory in 1999 and Brother Daoud in 2004.
